He also realized that the quotation at the end of the paragraph was awkward and ineffective. Make sure the information presented works with ideas in the body of the paper. Means-ends analysis. The test yields an overall score, as well as scores for each of the four domains. You can check for consistency at the end of the writing process. How would his readers know who Kwon was or why her opinion should be taken seriously? Checking for consistency is discussed later in this section. Adding an introductory phrase helped Jorge integrate this quotation smoothly and establish the credibility of his source. In upper-level biology courses that were redesigned by Knight and Wood , many students at first disliked and distrusted the interactive approach and the group activities. Check that it helps support a point and that it is clearly related to the other sentences in the paragraph. Tone is the attitude toward your subject and audience that you convey through your word choice. Students in the interactive course had significantly higher learning gains and better conceptual understanding than a group that previously took the same course taught with a lecture-based method. When she revised her essay, she deleted the off-topic sentences that affected the unity of the paragraph. What really matters is how much content students actually learn, not how much content an instructor presents in a lecture. Insight is especially important in creative or complex activities, such as a difficult physics problem or a design assignment in an architecture class. What is meant by a concept? Which would you keep and which were unnecessary? She looked for places where she needed to add a transition or perhaps reword the text to make the flow of ideas clear.
